The SLVYRA handicappers committee recommends the following classification:

I. The following types of yachts, with valid individual SLVYRA handicap, shall constitute the PHRF 1 class:

PHRF 1-A

Andrews 30, Bénéteau First 30-2, 36.7, 40CR et Class 10, Carrera 290, C+C 99, 110, 115, 121 et Mega 30, Etchells, Express 30M, F3, Fareast 23R et 28R, Farr 30 et 40, Frers 33, G&S 30, Hobie 33, Hotfoot 27, J27, 29, 30, 34, 35, 70, 80, 100, 105, et 111, Jeanneau S.O. 380, Kirby 30, Laser 28, LS 10, Mariah 27, Melges 24, Mirage 30 SX, Pearson Flyer 30, Reliance 12m, Santa Cruz 27, Seascape 27, Soling, Soverel 33, Star, Tartan Pride et Ten, Tofinou 9.5, Tripp 26, Viper 640, VX One, X402.

PHRF 1-B

Bénéteau First Class 8, Dragon, Farr 727, Formula 21, Fun 23, Holland 7.6, Hunter 22, Impulse 21, J22, J24, Kirby 25, Luna 24, Mini 650, Shield, Sonar 23, Sprinta Sport 23, SR Max 21, Tartan Fantail, Tempest 22, Ultimate 20, X79, Yngling.

- II. Yachts measuring 26,5 feet of overall length and over and having a valid individual SLVYRA time on time handicap and conform to the SLVYRA definition of a cruising yacht, with the exception of yachts designated under PHRF 1 Class, shall constitute the PHRF2 Class.
- III. Yachts measuring less than 26,5 feet of overall lenght and having a valid individual SLVYRA time on time handicap and conform to the SLVYRA definition of a cruising yacht, with the exception of yachts designated under PHRF 1 Class, shall constitute the PHRF3
 Class.
- **WS.** Yachts having a valid individual SLVYRA time on time handicap and conform to the SLVYRA definition of a cruising yacht, with the exception of yachts designated under PHRF 1 Class, who intend to race without a spinnaker, gennaker or Code One shall constitute the **WHITE SAIL Class**.
